Adults are pampered when they visit the Kai Mer Spa, featuring ocean-view treatment rooms with private outdoor showers, oceanfront pedicure and massage patios, 12-head Swiss hydro showers, steam rooms and saunas. After a soothing treatment, guests can read a book or take an afternoon nap under the swaying palms, listening to the sounds of the ocean.

Those guests who want to actively see more of St. Lucia can take advantage of Coconut Bay's unbeatable location close to the island's best attractions and activities. Through the Adventure St. Lucia desk in the lobby guests can book excursions to go zip-lining through the treetops on a canopy tour, riding ATVs, mountain biking in the

rainforest and hiking the Piton Mountains. For those who want to take to the water it's also possible to arrange for off-site snorkeling, scuba diving, windsurfing and kite boarding.
